

CONVENOR: SPRING SCHOOL PLANNING GROUP

The Spring School Planning Group... a sub-committee of Synod's Ministries Committee, plans and delivers an annual time of

learning, reflection and refreshment for the ministers, church related community workers and local church leaders of Southern Synod. The group comprises five ministers, one local church leader and the Synod TDO and the events are led by experienced external speakers for four days at High Leigh Conference Centre. The demand for leaders and conference centre spaces is high so the group usually has to plan at least two or three years ahead. Recognising differing needs and learning styles, the SSPG has adopted a three-year cycle of content and style, rotating between the foci of Bible Study, Retreat, and Praxis. Each conference includes teaching, prayer and reflection, plus time to relax and enjoy time with colleagues - the balance of these depends on the particular focus of each conference. In the last couple of years, participants have valued having more time to pray together in small groups called 'Travelling Companions': 'Prayer' will be the focus of this year's gathering in September. The Group is privileged to participate in God's mission by helping resource leaders for the benefit of all our churches. Participants consistently report that they value both the teaching and the opportunity to catch up with colleagues so we hope that all local churches will actively encourage their minister/CRCW/local church leader to attend these events.
