Church in focus SEAFORD, LEWES AND ALFRISTON URC

The current pandemic has had many tragic outcomes and caused so much disruption in all areas of life. The life of our churches has been no different to anyone else, with the closure of our buildings in Seaford (Cross Way Church LEP), Lewes (Christ Church LEP), and Alfriston URC (The Old Chapel) in East Sussex.

As for many, we provide a joint Sunday Worship Service via Zoom, including The Lord's Supper on the first Sunday, and a version of Messy Church on the 2nd Sunday. After the Service about 60% of the congregation stay on for "coffee" groups randomly assigned by Zoom. This has proved very popular with people getting to know those from the "other" congregation, or those they know less well. We produce a full Service sheet (usually 6 pages) which is emailed in advance, or posted out to those who are not technologically enabled.

as Cross Way Church is progressing towards its major redevelopment work to provide a building fit for mission in the heart of Seaford town centre
