

The Coronavirus (Covid-19) continues to emerge in the UK and throughout the rest of the world. NEW MALDEN AND THAMES DITTON

Now that we are under lockdown it seems strange sharing about a Pastorate that is not functioning as it did 3 months ago. New Malden reordered its sanctuary 3 years ago, the space created produced such a positive reaction that the church now refers to it as The Space. Alongside worship the space has organised fortnightly Lunchtime Concerts given by students from the Royal College and Royal Academy of Music. These concerts of a high standard have gained quite a following. Thames Ditton or Speer Road Church as it is now called has a loyal older congregation that have been finding maintaining worship and church life increasingly difficult. A project called Open Lounge targeted at carers and children on their way home from the local infant school has proved popular. Please pray for God's guidance as the churches consider their future after the lockdown.
