CHRIST CHURCH, SEVENOAKS & THE BAY, BIRCHINGTON

While languishing in Babylonian captivity the Jewish people were cut off from temple worship. So they began to meet in small groups (synagogues) to pray together & study their scriptures. A new type of spirituality was being developed that was to shape the worship of a future Christian church. In this age of COVID a good proportion of our two local congregations now meet together in zoom bible studies, prayer groups and online services. Of course some of the elderly struggle with the demands of internet technology. We also know that talking to each other on a laptop is less rewarding than sharing the physical presence of our friends. Nevertheless we, with many others, are discovering new ways of expressing our spirituality & growing in the faith that is helping some to participate actively who would normally have been more passive in their public worship. Perhaps something is taking place in our communities that will forever change the possibilities of Christian worship for good.
