



Ageing comes to all of us... but dementia doesn't. However, if you are over eighty years old, there is a one in six chance of developing it and this rises to one in three once you reach ninety. Dementia is irreversible and its onset often insidious. For those of us caring for older congregations, this represents a call to watchfulness and response, such as providing a dementia-friendly café or social "space", open to the local community, and/or some dementia-friendly special services.

WEST SUSSEX AREA MINISTRY

In the relatively rural West Sussex Area Ministry, in the long ago days before the pandemic, none of the three congregations in Billingshurst, Pulborough or Petworth had wi-fi in their buildings. We were deterred by lack of phone lines, and areas with poor mobile signal. There seemed, after all, no urgency... Then things changed.

We discovered the usefulness of Zoom when we couldn't gather in person, and our Zoom evening services (led from the Manse) still continue to attract a loyal, geographically-scattered congregation who appreciate their interactive potential (conversation)! We didn't think we needed to live-stream from the church buildings, but we find expectations are changing again. Folk have got used to funerals streamed online, whether from the local crematorium or elsewhere around the world. We are looking at wi-fi again... because it's good to stay connected and worship together, whatever that might look like.
